### Registration fees are as follows:

- **Puppy Class:** Up to 12 months old, \$35.00
- **Derby Class:** Any class up to 36 months old, \$40.00
- **Gun Dog:** Class is open to any dog, \$45.00
- **Senior Dog:** Class is open to dogs over 8-years-old, \$45.00

### Directions to Gates Shaw Farm

---

- Take I-65 and Exit at the Montevallo & Calera Exit onto AL Hwy 25.
- Go South on AL Hwy 25 through Calera, Montevallo & Wilton about 13 miles total to Bibb Co. Hwy 65 (about 7 miles from Wilton)
- Turn Right onto Bibb Co. Hwy 65 and go about 1 mile to Carlton Pass.
- Turn Right onto Carlton Pass and go to the dead end.
- The gate at the dead end is the entrance into Gates Shaw's Farm.
- Go through the gate to the designated parking area.

# AQH Scholarship

On August 3rd, 2015, the board of directors for Alabama Quail Hunters Inc. approved an operating scholarship to a college student.

The recipient must be a student with a declared major in wildlife, forestry, or agronomy. The amount of the scholarship will be \$1,000.

The scholarship will not be awarded to the same recipient in two consecutive years. The board of directors for Alabama Quail Hunters will retain sole authority with all aspects of the scholarship.

Generally it is understood that a student whose studies specialize in quail, fire, longleaf pines or native warm season grasses will receive



preference for the award. At the present time Alabama Quail Hunters has \$ 2,000 available to offer for scholarships.

Funding for this initial scholarship was made possible through a joint venture with Stan Wood, his wife Suzanne, and AQH, Inc.

Two opportunities never before offered are now available for the 2015/2016 season. Either R.J. Lott or Daniel Howell is offering them.

## **Lott**

R.J. Lott is near Elba and is offering hunting opportunities-including lodging. R.J. has 800 hundred acres of family land located on Coffee County Road 306. His wife offers pet grooming services for your dog.

For around \$1,000 you may find what you've been searching. R. J. is semi-retired from the construction business. He has moved back home and has renewed efforts to bring back wild quail. Daniel Howell is offering club memberships east of Dothan (off of State Road 84) in the Ashford community. The terrain is nearly flat which makes walking and hunting ideal! In addition to wild quail, Daniel is offering day shooting on pen raised quail as well as dove shoots.

Full memberships cost \$3,500 annually. Lodging is not offered. In nearby Dothan, along the Ross Clark Circle, there is plenty of lodging with rooms priced around \$100 per night.
